Wetty,

I hate to be a pest, but I still need to get a plow quote so the road association can decide what services they want and develop an annual budget.

If there's a fee for the quote, let me know, and I'll make sure we pay for it. You've been here for plow quotes four separate times now, at some point that's not free.

Here's what we need:

1) Base Quote:

- The basic plow run
- Including the cost of winging back the snow banks

2) Extra line items with separate costs:

- The charge for a pre-storm sanding for plow safety (we'll budget for a few of these)
- Any additional charge for plowing Indian Rest to the east, away from the ditch/culvert on the uphill side
- The cost of plowing out the turnaround halfway up the hill where the excavator was parked

Whatever you feel is reasonable.

If you say everything is included in the \$100 quote, that's fine. If the quote goes up, that's fine too. These things aren't free for you, so they shouldn't be free for us.

Then the neighbors will discuss and vote.
